To qualify: you must be currently STAYING at the Salvation Army (residency required, not just receiving day services). Step 1: work with your SA caseworker to develop your case management plan. Step 2: once your caseworker approves, talk to Matthew after SA breakfast or lunch to get on the list or fill an open spot. No need to call TFE: your SA caseworker is the gateway.

(2) Discovery Bible Study: open to everyone every Tuesday at Breaking Bread, no church background required. Eventual on-campus housing planned at the Village.

To qualify: at least 1 year living in Midland or Ector County, current housing is inadequate, unable to get a conventional loan, household income at or below 60% of area median, no felony in the past 7 years, and willing to complete about 350 sweat-equity hours plus a 16-week Homeowner College. Applications open on a limited yearly cycle: ask to join the reminder list.
